OUR MISSION

WHAT ARE YOU RUNNING FOR?

Pat's Run raises money for the Pat Tillman Foundation, which is building the leading fellowship program for military veterans and spouses. The vision of the Pat Tillman Foundation is to help develop the next generation of American public and private sector leaders committed to an idea or cause.

WHO WAS PAT TILLMAN?

Pat was a professional football player who walked away from a big-money NFL contract to enlist in the U.S. Army in the wake of 9/11. In April 2004, he died serving with the 75th Ranger Regiment in Afghanistan, and his memory lives on today through the work of the Pat Tillman Foundation.

WHAT IS THE PAT TILLMAN FOUNDATION?

Family and friends established the Pat Tillman Foundation following Pat's death in April 2004. Founded in 2008, the Tillman Scholars Program supports active-duty service members, veterans and their spouses with academic scholarships, a national network and professional development opportunities, so they are empowered to make an impact at home and around the world.

WHO ARE THE TILLMAN SCHOLARS?

Tillman Scholars are a select group of service members, veterans and military spouses to whom the foundation grants academic scholarships so they can pursue their dreams of continued service – both in and out of uniform. These scholars are creating positive change in the fields of medicine, law, business, education, the arts and more.





Setting up a fundraising page is easy and is now done in RunSignUp which is the same platform as Pat's Run Registration. Every donation you gather will help Tillman Scholars achieve their dreams to further their education and continued service. To get started, click on the Start Your Fundraiser button below. Then scroll down to Become a Fundraiser. Complete the required information, and follow the prompts to create your custom fundraiser name, URL, and personal message.
